The Student Parliamentary Council (SPC) is elected by all students each year in a democratic vote.

The SPC has a president (6th year) appointed by the principal.

The SPC meet once a month and the president liaises with the principal regularly to ensure the student voice is heard.

Our Prefects are selected 6th year students who are mentors to and often confidants to the 1st 2nd and 3rd years. They liaise closely with tutors and other staff members

The Ember Team are a faith development team. They are appointed at the end of 4th year.

They work particularly closely with our 1st year students especially settling them into school during the 1st few weeks

These students liaise with the guidance, chaplain and RE team to enhance the wellbeing of students

The Anti-Bullying Ambassadors are students from 2nd to 6th year who coordinate a range of activities around the school. They run COSY CORNER each lunch time where students can meet to watch movies, play board games and interact socially with one another. They keep an eye on vulnerable students and liase with Anti-Bullying Committee.
