Vehicle Parking Policy for Students

The number of parking spaces available on the Mount Sackville Campus is limited and the parking available is adequate for staff and a small number of visitors only. Consequently it is not possible to provide parking for students between the hours of 7:00 am and 4:15 pm

Parking is available to students between 4.15 pm and 7:00pm
(On Wednesdays between 1:25pm and 6:00pm)

The following rules must be observed

Students must register their cars with the Deputy Principal and obtain a Parking Permit.

Parking Permits will only be issued to full licence holders.

It is the responsibility of parents/students to ensure that cars are roadworthy and are licensed and insured as required by law.

The student assumes all responsibility for loss or damage to her car, its equipment and its contents - **Mount Sackville will not assume responsibility for any damage to or loss of property from the car while it is parked on school grounds.**

Students are **not** permitted to carry other passengers, other than siblings. Any student who uses a vehicle to transport other students will lose the privilege of parking on school grounds.

The Rules of the Road apply on school grounds – Safe driving habits should always be observed.
